March is National Women's History Month

In 1987 the US Congress designated March as National Women's History Month. This creates a special opportunity to recognize and celebrate the often-overlooked achievements of American women. This year's theme is: *NEVERTHELESS SHE PERSISTED: Honoring Women Who Fight All Forms of Discrimination Against Women.*

This theme honors women who have shaped America's past and future through their tireless commitment to ending discrimination against women and girls. The theme embodies women working together with strength, tenacity and courage to overcome obstacles and achieve joyful accomplishments.

The roots of National Women's History Month go back to March 8, 1857, when women from various New York City facto-

ries staged a protest over working conditions. The first Women's Day Celebration in the U.S. was in New York City in 1909, but Congress did not establish National Women's History Week until 1981. In 1987, Congress expanded the week to a month. Every year since, Congress has passed a resolution for Women's History Month, and the president has issued a proclamation.


