YOU HAVE ACCESS TO LIBRARIES ALL OVER IOWA!

The State of Iowa Libraries Online Interlibrary Loan system (SILO ILL) offers resource sharing services to all types of libraries in Iowa. Because of limited resources and space, we cannot buy all published items, but through SILO ILL we can borrow titles from another library when they are available.

When you are seeking a title that is at least one year old but we do not have that item at the Bertha Bartlett Public Library, you may request that we check SILO for it or we may suggest it as an option. We will do a search through our locator to see if the title is available through any other Iowa library. If it is, we will put in a request for the item. We do charge \$1 for this service to help with shipping costs and you must have an active patron account with us.

With SILO ILL, you even have access to college and university materials. We have received titles from all over the state. If you are seeking a title we don't have, ask us about getting it through Interlibrary Loan!

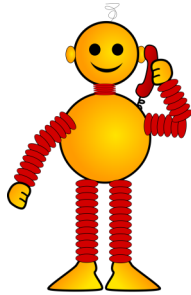

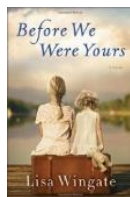
