# We put the "story" in Story City!







We are thrilled to share a new feature of Bridges with you: magazine checkouts! The new feature has already had 432 magazines accessed by patrons in the first day it was available. The feature will be available for a year; staff will gauge patron interest and usage to determine if it should become a permanent feature of the eLibrary.

Magazines are currently available on Bridges as a special collection through both the Over-Drive and Libby app, and on library websites in the browser (via Over-Drive Read). They have no wait lists or holds, do not count towards checkout limits, and provide readers the option to renew their selections. Readers can also download magazines on Libby for offline use.

This pilot was made possible through federal funds from the Institute of Museum and Library Services. The collection budget was not affected by this program.



#### DID YOU KNOW YOU COULD DO THAT AT THE LIBRARY?

You can scan a document straight to your email at the library. This service is available on our copier. To scan your document to your email, lay your document print side up in the feeder tray on the copier. Tap the "Easy Scan" icon on the screen. Tap the "email address" bar to enter your email address. After typing in the receiving email address, tap "OK", then tap "B&W Start". Your document will feed through the copier for scanning and email straight to your address as a .pdf file. There is no charge for this service.


