## Set Your Child on the Road to Academic Success Early!



The Bertha Bartlett Library is a proud participant in the 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten program!

Numerous studies have established that by age three (3), a child's brain has reached 80 percent of its adult volume. The brain develops most rapidly during the first 1,000 days of a child's life. A toddler's brain creates up to two million new connections every second. Early experiences and interactions are a key factor in a child's brain development. The ability to learn language skills is greatest before the age of six (6). Early literacy skills have a lifelong impact on educational and occupational success. The most important predictor of school success

is being read to at home during early childhood.

It is easy to participate: just ask for a book log at the Circulation Desk Track the books you and your child read and earn a prize at every hundred mark. Then start the next level with a new book log. If you read just one book a day with your child, you'll reach 1,000 books in less than three years!
